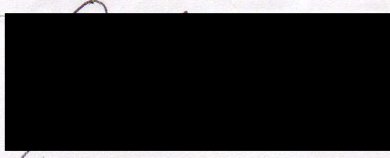
ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT (SCOTLAND) REGULATIONS 1999 - CONSTRUCTION OF A LANDFILL FACILITY AT WESTERN EDGE (EAST OF TURNINGSHAW ROAD) OF THE ROYAL ORDNANCE SITE, STATION ROAD, BISHOPTON

I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your letter of 30 October, enclosing three copies of an Environmental Statement relating to the above development. As you know, we cannot comment on the planning application but only on the Statement itself.

Under the 1999 Regulations, the Scottish Ministers have 28 days to consider the Statement, and our consideration period will begin from 01 Novemeber, when we received these documents.

Accordingly, the papers are now being circulated to interested parties within the Executive, who have been asked to send responses direct, within the aforementioned time-scale. However, if any of these parties have queries, or require additional time to reply, they have been advised to contact you to negotiate, by agreement, a revised deadline, etc.
